Certificate Presentation Ceremony For The Turkish Language Course For Professional In Hospitality And Tourism Industry

- 1. Bandar Seri Begawan, 23rd January 2025** - To recognize the achievements of nine professionals in the Hospitality and Tourism industry who successfully completed a Turkish language course, the Ministry of Primary Resources through the Tourism Development Department hosted the certificate presentation ceremony for the Turkish language course which took place on 23rd January 2025, at Setia Pahlawan Hall, Ministry of Primary Resources and Tourism. Also present was His Excellency Prof. Dr. Hamit Ersoy, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of The Republic of Turkiye.
- 2.** The Turkish language course, which took place from 2nd July to 3rd December, 2024 was organized through a collaboration between the Tourism Development Department, Ministry of Primary Resources and Tourism, Embassy of The Republic of Turkiye and Institute of Brunei Technical Education.
- 3.** This collaboration aims to include Tourist Guides and Hotel Front Liners in Brunei Darussalam to learn and be able to speak in Turkish. The main objective of conducting this course is to enhance professional competency in the Hospitality and Tourism sector by equipping participants with basic Turkish language skills to provide better and more engaging services and experiences for Turkish-speaking tourists.
- 4.** The course equips participants with the fundamental Turkish grammar and vocabulary needed for basic communication in everyday situations. Focusing on speaking, reading, writing and listening skills, the module enables participants to introduce themselves and others, ask and answer simple personal questions, and understand common daily expressions. This provides a practical foundation for social interaction at a beginner level.
- 5.** The Tourism Development Department is committed to elevating the quality of Hospitality and Tourism services in Brunei Darussalam. A range of new training programs has been developed for the Tourism industry to ensure that professionals possess the necessary skills and knowledge to deliver high-quality services, thereby further enriching the visitor experience.
